



## ALTO CACHAPOAL - CHILE

## PROFUNDO 2011 A WINE WORTHY OF PRAISE

This is the ICON red wine of VALLE SECRETO, a 100 acres modern vineyard planted in the argillaceous piedmont of the central chilean Andes mountains. With ALTO CACHAPOAL as Origin Denomination, a surprisingly worthy terroir, and vines carefull practices made all by hand, most of our winegrape stocks, specially in reds, are showing continuous year by year quality improvements.

The excellent 2011 vintage result was explained by lower temperatures observed during the year, with grape clusters showing a strong fresh fruit expression, full of fragrances and flavors, and a high concentration of delicate tannins.

With the experience of nice distinctions previously obtained for previous lines, the 2011 exceptional conditions encouraged the prompt selection of the best blocks in the vineyard to produce a real ICON. Each block contributes with a special character to the final blend, each vine delivering its own style.

## **MAIN DEFINITIONS**

VARIETIES: 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 20% Syrah, 10% Malbec, 10% Petit Verdot, and 10% Carmenere.

D.O.: Alto Cachapoal

CLIMATE: Mediterranean, semiarid.

SOIL: Colluvial

HARVEST: Hand picked.

PRODUCTION YIELD: 4 to 5 pounds per vine.

## TASTING NOTES

COLOR: Deep red cherry.

AROMA: Elegant and complex, with ripe red fruits, spicy notes, flowers, tobacco and chocolate. Wide aromatic

palette.

PALATE: Solid structure, concentrated, elegant and strong tannins, in a good body. Well balanced and long finish.

AGING: Two years in french oak barrels, 500 liters

capacity, first use.

STORAGE: Eighteen months prior release to market.

PRODUCTION: 3.043 bottles.

MAIN ANALYSIS: Alcohol: 14,5 % pH: 3,49

Total Acidity: 5,88 g/L
